You could be:

- Overseeing the design and manufacturing of agricultural machinery in **India**;
- Designing and building an adaptor for clay water filters to improve drinking water in **Mexico**;
- Supporting an ongoing rural water supply programme by reviewing the design of the systems and providing project management advice in **The Gambia**;
- Supporting the design, planning and construction of composting toilet units, monitoring construction sites and providing support to local masons during construction in **Rwanda**;
- Working with a small NGO to research and develop improved methods of production of local construction materials in **Bangladesh**;
- Developing, running and managing a 'Think like an Engineer' teaching module at rural schools in **Sierra Leone**;
- Mentoring two local graduates to improve ways of working for a local water authority in **Cameroon**.

All volunteers receive comprehensive pre-departure training, full support whilst in the UK and overseas, and all expenses such as accommodation, food, in-country travel and insurance are all covered. Volunteers are supported to fundraise £600-900 on behalf of EWB-UK.
